Established in 1965, the choir has performed at some of the world's most prestigious venues, such as Walt Disney Concert Hall and Carnegie Hall, where they have premiered groundbreaking works and collaborated with distinguished contemporary composers. The ensemble consists of approximately 40 students, who are pursuing a wide array of graduate and undergraduate degrees in disciplines ranging from engineering and math to music and science.
